BADMINTON SECTION BYE-LAWS

1. a) The Badminton Section Committee may reserve the badminton court as necessary for Club matches, Tournaments and other special purposes.
b) The Badminton Section Committee shall determine sessions for Club organised play at the beginning of each season and circulate all Badminton Members accordingly.
2. a) Shuttlecocks are provided by the Club except for summer play.
b) An Annual Shuttlecock Fee as determined by the Committee shall be paid by all playing Members with their due subscriptions.
c) A Match Fee when playing both home and away shall be paid by all Members to the Captain of the team at the time of the match and the total fees from any match shall be handed into the Club office by the Captain as soon as possible.
3. Senior applicants for membership of the Badminton Section shall be required to attend a playing-in session for Club organised sessions arranged under the direction of the Badminton Membership Secretary.
4. a) During Club organised playing sessions all play shall be determined by the order-of-play board.
b) No Four may commence another game if any person is waiting to play.
c) No Single shall be started if a Four is waiting to play.
5. Junior Badminton Members may only play at times allocated by the Badminton Section Committee.
6. Members who bring children to the Club must ensure that they are kept under proper surveillance and no child is allowed in the badminton hall or clubroom unless under the control of a responsible adult.
7. No footwear shall be worn that is liable to injure or mark the playing surface.
8. Permission to use the badminton hall for purposes other than Badminton shall normally be granted by the Club Committee after consultation with the Badminton Section Committee. Interim permission may be granted by the Chairman of the Badminton Section prior to the next meeting of the Club Committee.
9. Members are required to wear during the course of play predominantly white and/or light matching or co-ordinating pastel clothing, which must be of one colour only or one predominant colour co-ordinated with white. All items worn must be recognised badminton clothing. Coloured pullovers or track suits are permitted as a top garment. Shoes should be predominantly white with non-marking soles. Slogans (except for the Club motif) are not permissible.
